	Is there a mobile app, featuring real-time updates throughout the day (including photos and videos)?		
	Are there family-teacher conferences throughout the year to learn about your child's development?		
	Do teachers compile portfolios of your child's work and learning, to share their progress, and for you to have as a keepsake?		
LEARNING AND PROGRAMS	Does the school offer a research-based educational approach?		
	Are programs based on age-appropriate learning and developmental objectives?		
	Are learning experiences personalized based on what each child is ready to learn?		
	Do teachers spend one-on-one time with children?		
	Is there a plan for tracking and achieving developmental goals?		
	Are extracurricular activities (such as Spanish, yoga, fitness and more) offered?		
FOOD AND FITNESS	Does the school have a health and fitness program?		
	Are meals and snacks provided?		
	Are food offerings approved by a registered dietitian nutritionist?		
	Do children have physical activity (outdoors when possible) every day?		
COSTS	How much does it cost per week?		
	What is the registration fee?		
	Are there hidden costs? Meals, streaming video, etc.?		
	Is transportation available to/from your child's primary school? Is there an extra cost?
